

What is the Children's Trust Fund?

CTF, established in 1982, is an independent statewide non-profit organization dedicated to the prevention of child abuse and neglect. CTF serves as a voice for all children and families to promote their health, safety and welfare by supporting and funding effective collaborative programs and services that prevent child abuse and neglect. CTF's primary source of funding is the interest from a trust fund. Other sources of financial support are the Children's License Plate, tax deductible donations, fundraising, and state and federal grants. CTF currently partners with local prevention councils that serve 82 of Michigan's 83 counties.

The CA/N Team is a designated local council of the Michigan

Children's Trust Fund for Alpena and Presque Isle Counties. It was formed in 1978 and incorporated in 1985 as a non-profit organization. The coalition is made up of a group of volunteers, both lay and professional, committed to helping children and their families.

Vision and Values of the CA/N Team

- **Vision**

An organization dedicated to assuring that all children in Alpena and Presque Isle counties live in an environment free of child abuse and neglect.

- **Values**

-Children need to be safe, valued and free from child abuse and neglect.

-Programs and services can help parents to keep their children safe and free from child abuse and neglect.

-Our communities have the capability of increasing the prevention of child abuse and neglect.

Current Projects

- **Alpena County Baby Pantry**

We operate a baby Pantry in Alpena County. Families who are in need may visit the pantry one day each month to request food, clothing or health care items for children 0-3 years of age.

- **Alpena Exchange Club partner**

The Exchange Club has, as one of its missions to reduce child abuse and neglect in the area. We collaborate on fundraisers, events and community education.

- **Parenting Education**

On our own or in collaboration with other organizations in the community, the CA/N Team offers parent education by hosting or sponsoring various programs, workshops or conferences to parents and guardians.

- **Professional Development**

CA/N offers professional development opportunities to parents, caregivers and professionals in the community by offering mandated reporter workshops and conferences on various topics. The team also distributes a quarterly newsletter.

- **Program Support Dollars**

Twice yearly, the CA/N Team designates CTF dollars to local non-profit organizations to support programs designed to prevent the incidence of child abuse and neglect.
